## ROOM ASSIGNMENTS

Your room assignments were sent out earlier this week. If you missed that email, you can check your room assignment [here](#). Curious to know what your building or room type will be like? You can find information [here](#).

## WHEN CAN I MOVE IN?

You can now sign up for a [move-in day time slot!](#) The first time slot available is Sunday at 8:30 a.m., and the last is at 3:00 p.m. To space things out, each building has a limit to the number of student check-ins per time slot. ## **CAN I SHIP MYSELF PACKAGES PRIOR TO MOVE IN?**

Now that you know your room assignment, please remember that the Student Housing Desk is not able to accept packages and deliveries prior to your move-in day. If you are having anything shipped to your residence, please make sure it arrives after move-in day.

## **HOW DO I GET A PARKING PASS FOR THIS ACADEMIC YEAR?**

If you need to park a vehicle on campus during the academic year, you will have to apply for a parking permit. Spaces are very limited and permits are not guaranteed. ## **APPLY FOR YOUR UBC CARD**

Your UBCcard is your meal plan, your bus pass, your printing account and your identification!

Have you sent in your photo for your UBCcard yet? If not, visit [Card Services](#) and complete the online application. Make sure you select 'UBC Residence - Yes'. Photos must be in JPG/JPEG format - a colour head shot with clear view of face (no hats, no sunglasses, no silly faces) on a plain background.

**\*\*Photo must be received BEFORE midnight, Sunday, August 28th 2022 \*\*** in order for your UBCcard to be included in your Move-in Package.

Any applications received after the deadline are not guaranteed to be available in your Move-in Package.

## WHAT IF I NO LONGER PLAN ON LIVING IN RESIDENCE?

If you no longer plan to live in residence at UBC Okanagan, please [cancel your housing offer](#) immediately, so we can offer the unit to another student who may need housing.
