Welcome to Residence at UBC!

We're so excited for you to be joining us at UBCO this fall! We know you have questions — and there's lots to learn. Not to worry, we have plenty of resources to help you prepare for life in residence!

Here are three things you should know about this week:

1. Important Dates

We have three major move-in days:

- Summer Migration residents: **Aug. 20 & 21** (more on that coming soon)
- Jump Start residents: Aug. 26 & 27
- All other residents: **Sept. 3**

2. About your offer

Residence area and room type

At this point in the process, the offer you received is tied to an area within residence. We'll let you know your specific room assignment in mid-August, once we've completed all of our allocations.

At that time, you'll either be assigned to a room in one of our traditional <u>first-year</u>
<u>residences</u> (Cassiar, Nicola, Purcell, Valhalla, Kalamalka, Skeena, Nechako, or
<u>Similkameen Place</u>) or in a suite-style residence (<u>Lower/Upper Cascades</u> or <u>Monashee</u>

Place). While we do our best to accommodate the preferences you listed in your application, we can't guarantee first-choice placements.

Room assignments and gender

Room assignments are based on the gender you identified in your residence application, and your preferences for roommate placements (if applicable).

For students who indicated a Trans or Non-binary identity on their application, keep an eye out for an email from us with an invitation to provide a bit more info about your room assignment preferences.
