Move-in is coming quickly! Thank you for your patience these past few weeks as we've made adjustments to our move-in process due to the recent wildfires in Kelowna.

1. Connecting with Roommates

- Looking to connect with your roommate? Log in to your <u>Online</u>
 <u>Housing Service Centre</u> and navigate to "Residence", "Before
 Moving in" and then "Contact Room/Unit Mate".
- Interested in a different room? Please log on to our <u>Room Switch</u> <u>Forum</u> and connect with another student who aligns with a room swap.

2. Have you signed up for a Move-In Day Time Slot?

All residents must sign up for a Move-<u>in day time slot.</u> If you haven't signed up yet, please do so today. <u>SIGN UP HERE</u> in Day time slot <u>here.</u> If you plan on arriving after 4:30 pm on Sunday, come to the front desk in Nechako - it's open 24 hours a day!

3. Last chance to get your UBCcard

The deadline to apply for your UBCcard in time for Move-In Day has been extended to **Thursday**, **August 31**. This is especially important if you are on Meal Plan as your UBCcard is your access to Pritchard Dining Hall. Visit <u>Card Services</u> to complete the online application.

4. What should I pack and do to prepare now?

Who can come with me?

- Students are invited to bring up to **two people** and **one vehicle** to help them move in. If you are arriving with a vehicle, one driver must stay with your car while you are unloading. Volunteers will also be located at all residence buildings to help you unload and move in!
- Trailers and boats are not permitted. If you are coming with an oversized vehicle you will be required to leave it in H Lot's overflow parking prior to check-in.
