Happy August, and welcome to your Move-in email #2!

We'll be sending weekly emails with important information regarding your move-in day, and what to expect when you arrive at residence. Here are four things you need to know this week:

1. When can I move in?

- Current Summer Students: Your migration dates (to move to your winter residence) are August 20 and 21. We'll email you with more on that later this week.
- Jump Start and Early Arrival Students: Aug. 26 & 27. Only residents with approved <u>early arrival</u> due to orientation programs (like those participating in Jump Start) and early academic programs, etc. are permitted to prior to Sept. 3.
- **All other Residents**: Your move-in day is Sunday, September 3. You'll receive an email later this month inviting you to sign up for a move-in time slot.

2. Apply for your UBCcard

Your UBCcard is your meal plan, bus pass, printing account and ID!

Visit <u>Card Services</u> to apply online. Make sure you select 'UBC Residence - Yes'. Your photo must be a colour headshot with clear view of your face (no hats) on a plain background.

If you want your UBCcard to be included in your Move-in Package, your **photo <u>must</u> be received BEFORE midnight, Monday, August 21st (for Jump Start and other Early Arrival students), and Sunday, August 27th for all other incoming residents.**.

Meal Plan students: You need a physical UBCcard to enter Pritchard Dining Hall.

3. Meal Plans and Food Services

If you're assigned to a first-year residence, you'll be signed up for the All-Access Meal Plan as part of your Student Housing Contract. This lets you eat as often as you like at Pritchard Dining Hall – located in Nechako Residence. Other Meal Plan options are available for residents who are not on the mandatory All-Access Meal Plan.

4. Third Party Authorization

To grant a third-party (such as a parent or spouse) permission to access your information, you must go to <u>Student Service Centre</u> and select Personal Information > <u>Third-Party Authorization</u>. If this step is not completed, we won't be able to help anyone but you with anything regarding your account.

If you no longer need residence on campus please <u>cancel your housing</u>
