1. Your Packing Checklist

Wondering what to pack and what to leave at home? Check out our checklist [here](#).

Some highlights:

- **Not provided** by Student Housing (please bring or purchase upon arrival):
 - Bed linens, pillows & towels
 - Clothes hangers and laundry hamper
 - Dishes, cutlery and other cooking supplies
- **Supplied** by Student Housing:
 - Bed and mattress
 - Desk, chair, dresser
 - Oven, stove, fridge, microwave (these are in suite-style residences, and on every floor lounge)
- **For optional** items like mini fridges), prohibited items (like hot plates), and our full packing checklist, [visit this page](#).

2. Apply for Parking (if you need it)

Did you know that 85% of students in residence don't bring a car with them? Learn more about why you [don't need a vehicle to get around](#).

If you need to park a vehicle on campus during the academic year, you'll have to apply for a parking permit. Spaces are very limited, and permits are awarded based on a waitlist system. **Mark your calendars:** [Resident Student Permit waitlists](#) open **August 15, 2024 at 9 am PST**.

3. Order your Beddings and Linens

Student Housing does not provide bedding or bath linens. You can bring your own from home or buy them.

- The UBCO Bookstore sells bedding (and other dorm room must-haves)! [Order online](#) to have your bedding ready for pick-up at the Bookstore on move-in day.
- Or visit [Campus Linens of Canada](#), which can deliver to residence before you arrive. The deadline to order bedding from Canada Linens so it's ready for your arrival on Jump Start move-in is **Aug. 13**, and for Aug. 31 move-in the deadline is **Aug. 18**.

Please note: The Nechako residence has a Double XL size bed while all other Single Connected residences have a Single XL size bed.

4. Can I ship packages to myself before move-in?

The Student Housing Desk is not able to accept packages and deliveries prior to [your move-in day](#) (except orders placed through [Campus Linens Canada](#)). If you are having anything shipped to your residence, please make sure it arrives on or after your move-in day. You can find all residence mailing addresses [here](#).
