

## Welcome to Week 4 of Move-in emails!

### 1. Connecting with Roommates

Looking to connect with your roommate? Log in to your [Online Housing Service Centre](#) and navigate to "Residence", "Before Moving in" and then "Contact Room/Unit Mate".

### 2. Last chance to get your UBCCard

The deadline to apply for your UBCCard in time for your move-in day is:

- **Tomorrow (Wednesday, August 21)** for Jump Start and Early Arrival students, and
- **Sunday, August 25th** for all other incoming residents.

**Meal Plan students:** You need your physical UBCCard to enter Pritchard Dining Hall.

- All residents are encouraged to aim for a litter-less move-in. If you have waste after unpacking, please take it with you or bring it to the free Recycling Drop-off station at the Glenmore Landfill, adjacent to campus.

## 4. Important info about Aug. 31 move-in

For those moving on Aug. 31, you'll receive an email soon inviting you to sign up for a move-in time slot.

### Who can come with me?

- Students are invited to bring up to **two people** and **one vehicle** to help them move in. If you are arriving with a vehicle, one driver must stay with your car while you are unloading. Volunteers will also be at all residence buildings to help you unload and move in!
- Trailers and boats are not permitted. If you are coming with an oversized vehicle you will be required to leave it in H Lot's overflow parking prior to check-in.
