Register for a Jump Start Move-in Time Slot and about your Move-in Day

This final move-in email is full of important information to know ahead of your move-in next week. If you can't read it now, flag it and make sure you circle back later today. If you missed the previous emails you, can find them on our Move-in Page! Here are seven things you need to know about move-in:

1. Please sign up for a move-in time slot

You can now sign up for a <u>move-in day time slot!</u> To space things out, each building has a limit to the number of student check-ins per time slot. Before signing up, make sure you know what building you are moving into. You can double check that <u>here.</u>

If you plan on arriving later than the last available time slot, come to the front desk in Nechako - it's open 24 hours a day!

2. Where should I go and how will check-in work?

If you are arriving by vehicle, you will be coming to UBCO Campus and heading straight to <u>F Lot</u> with additional parking in E Lot. **Bring your photo ID!**

From F Lot, head to Nechako – it's the residence building directly beside the parking lot, and check in with the registration desk in Nechako's Gathering Room. Once you have registered, you will be directed to the Front Desk where you will pick up your room keys and get directions to find your building.

3. How will unloading work?

Follow directions from F Lot to your building. You will have 15 minutes to unload your vehicle and move it to a nearby lot. Doing this before unpacking your room ensures that

space in front of buildings is available for others to use. We recommend parking lots G, R, S or W lots after you have unloaded at your building.

All residents are encouraged to aim for a litter-less move-in. If you have waste after unpacking, please take it with you or bring it to the free Recycling Drop-off station at the Glenmore Landfill, adjacent to campus.

4. Where should I park?

Parking on campus is complimentary for Jump Start participants only. You must register your plate. You can do that in advance by clicking here. Note that vehicles can not be left parked near the entrance to residence buildings.

5. What if I'm going to be arriving later?

Arriving after 5 pm on Tuesday, or later in the week? Visit our Front Desk in Nechako Residence (open 24/7) and we'll be happy to help.
