Welcome to Week 5 of Move-in emails!

If you missed the previous emails you, can find them <u>on our Move-in Page!</u> Here are four things you need to know about move-in this week:

1. Your Packing Checklist

Wondering what to pack and what to leave home? Visit our checklist <u>here</u>. Some highlights:

- Not provided by Student Housing (please bring from home, or purchase upon arrival):
 - o Bed linens, pillows & towels (a mattress protector is provided)
 - Clothes hangers and laundry hamper
 - o Dishes, cutlery and other cooking supplies
 - **Supplied** by Student Housing:
 - o Bed, mattress and mattress protector
 - o Desk, chair, dresser
 - Window blinds & shower curtain
 - Stove, fridge, microwave (these are in suite-style residences, and on every floor lounge)
- **For optional** items (like mini fridges only allowed in some rooms), prohibited items (like hot plates), and our full packing checklist, <u>visit this page</u>.

2. Order your Beddings and Linens

Student Housing does not provide bedding or bath linens. You can bring your own from home or buy them.

- The UBCO Bookstore sells bedding (and other dorm room must-haves)! Order online to have your bedding ready for pick-up at the Bookstore on move-in day.
- Or visit <u>Campus Linens of Canada</u>, which can deliver to residence before you arrive.
 The deadline to order bedding from Campus Linens so it's ready for your arrival on
 Jump Start Move-in Day is **Aug. 14**, and for Aug. 30 Move-in Day the deadline is **Aug. 20**. For delivery: if you don't yet know your residence, go to "Note" section and
 enter "Residence Unknown" along with your student number and move-in date.

For information, about **what size** of bedding to order, check the "Bedding/Linens" section of this page under "What should I bring?"

3. Can I ship packages to myself before move-in?

The Student Housing Desk cannot accept packages and deliveries before <u>your move-in</u> <u>day</u> (except orders placed through <u>Campus Linens Canada</u>). If you are having anything shipped to your residence, please make sure it arrives on or after your move-in day.

4. Apply for Parking (if needed!)

Did you know that 85% of students in residence don't bring a car with them? Learn more about why you don't need a vehicle to get around.

If you need to park a vehicle on campus during the academic year, you'll have to apply for a <u>resident student permit</u>. Spaces are very limited, and permits are awarded based on a waitlist system. Before the waitlist opens, review the <u>Pre-Permit Checklist.</u>

Mark Your Calendars: Resident student waitlists open on August 12 at 9am PST. At that time, log in to your <u>parking account</u> and select: "Add/Edit Waitlist". Resident student permit awards will be sent out starting Aug 18th

If you're arriving for Jump Start (or other early arrivals) with a vehicle, you'll need to buy a parking pass for the last week of August.

5. Reminders

No problem! When you arrive, please visit the Student Housing Main Office in Nechako Residence and we'll be happy to help. Our front desk is open 24 hours a day, so someone will be here to set you up with your room key(s) regardless of the time you arrive.

Cancellations

If you no longer need residence on campus, please cancel your housing offer immediately through the <u>Online Service Centre</u> to open space for those who do require on-campus housing.
